



Support to Mediterranean doctoral studies

Objective

The IAMM has always been known for its tradition of welcoming students and its aim is to systematize this function and make it a priority. We host teachers and associated researchers for a given period, or on sabbatical leave, or even within the framework of research programs. We also receive doctoral students. These arrangements are made for short or average length stays. Those hosted are mainly involved in teaching and research activities and in networks animated by the Institute or to which it is associated.

The IAMM, a laboratory welcoming doctoral students (LAMES)

Doctoral students admitted in the Mediterranean Laboratory in Economics and Social sciences (LAMES) at the IAMM are inserted into the Institute's research teams. Thus, they benefit from the Institute's available facilities (offices, class rooms, etc.)

Doctoral stays may be of short or average duration depending on the university where the thesis has been registered.

- A student registered at a university in a partner country, whose doctoral work is integrated into an inter-institutional collaborative project, can be received at the IAMM for several short stays occurring during his thesis preparation.
- A student registered at a French university, having as thesis supervisor or co-supervisor a teacher-researcher at the IAMM, can be admitted during the whole period of his thesis preparation.

A privileged collaboration is maintained with several universities in Montpellier, mainly with the jointly supervised Montpellier SupAgro-UM1 doctoral training programme "Economy and management of farm, agri-food and rural development" as well as the UM3 doctoral training programme.

On average, the IAMM yearly receives about fifty doctoral students for short, average or long stays.

Admission

Doctoral projects admitted by the research unit must be related to one of the thematic axes structuring the Institute's scientific and teaching activities:

- Agriculture, rural territories, sustainable food
- Mediterranean agricultures, use of natural resources
- Mediterranean agri-food chains and quality
- Agricultural, rural and food policies, negotiation

Short-stay doctoral applicants are admitted on the proposal of IAMM teachers-researchers. The doctoral programme must also lie within the scope of institutional relations entertained with the research and training centers of the Mediterranean basin.

Applications to doctoral programmes are to be sent directly to doctoral schools concerned.

Research allowances

For long-stay applications, admission is decided by a selection committee.

Only two research allowances are allotted for the whole period of doctoral studies (3 years). Specific allowances can be allotted for short stays.

Diploma

Doctoral diplomas are proper to the universities awarding them, the Institute acting as welcoming laboratory.
